TS01237438	This cookie is involved in enforcing elements of the security policy with regard to database management in the hosting servers. No personal data is

BIGipServerZebedee	This cookie is part of the back-end architecture of the hosting service that manages the site. It is a load-balancing cookie which is required to track the particular server you are connected so that you receive a consistent user experience as navigate between pages. The cookie makes sure the content of the page you are visiting loads quickly and effectively by routing data and page requests to the correct server. No personal data is collected, and it is deleted at the end of your browsing session.
